**DRUG USE IN GERMANTOWN** – Emphasis on prescription drugs – May 12 from 6:30 – 8:30 pm at GHS.

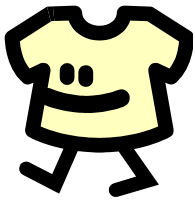

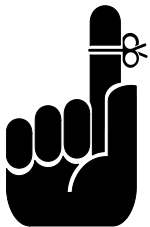
